Being a by-law to authorize the execution of an agreement with Timms Construction for alteration and addition to the municipal building.

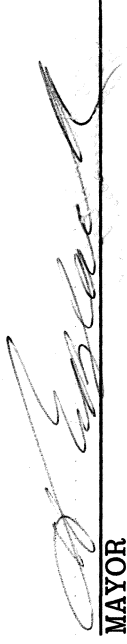
WHEREAS the Town of Pelham Council has accepted the tender of Timms Construction for the addition to the municipal building and necessary alterations connected therewith as it was the lowest tender,

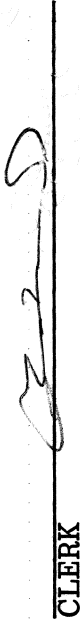
AND WHEREAS for such purposes deemed expedient to authorize the execution of an agreement with the said contractor,

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT for the purpose aforesaid the Mayor and the Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham and to affix the Corporate Seal to an agreement, dated February 18th., 1974 made between the Corporation of the Town of Pelham and Timms Construction, a copy of which is attached hereto.
- (2) THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day upon which it is finally passed.
