

TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW NO. 22

BEING A BY-LAW FOR ENTERING INTO CONTRACT WITH
THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE FOR ONTARIO FOR THE
PURPOSE OF HAVING THAT PORTION OF THE TOWN OF
PELHAM FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE VILLAGE OF FONTHILL
POLICED BY THE ONTARIO PROVINCIAL POLICE.

WHEREAS It is provided by the Police Act, R.S.O. 1960,
Chapter 298, that subject to the approval of the Lieutenant-
Governor in Council, the Commissioner may enter into an Agree-
ment with the Council of any municipality for the policing of the
Municipality, by the Ontario Provincial Police.

AND WHEREAS It is considered desirable to enter into such an
agreement, to be effective January 1, 1970.

NOW BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF PELHAM:

- (1) THAT The Mayor and Clerk be empowered to enter into
such an agreement and they are hereby authorized and
directed to sign the engrossment of said proposed
agreement and affix to it the Corporate Seal of the
Municipality.
