

THE CORPORATION OF THE  
TOWN OF PELHAM  
BY-LAW #2437 (2002)

Being a by-law to approve the temporary closure of Orchard Hill  
Road in the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS Section 207, Subsection 43 (a) to (d) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990,  
Chapter M.45 allows for the temporary closing of any highway or portion of a highway under the  
jurisdiction of the municipality for any period during the construction, repairing or improvement of  
such highway or portion thereof or of any works under, over, along, across or upon such highway  
or portion thereof;


AND WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it  
necessary to temporarily close Orchard Hill Road annually for a period as determined by Council in  
order to ensure public safety;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN  
OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT Orchard Hill Road, from approximately 45m east of the centre line of Sulphur  
Springs Drive to approximately 75m west of the intersection of Luffman Drive and Orchard Hill  
Road and from approximately 192m west of the Pelham/Thorold Town Line to approximately 135m  
east of the intersection of Luffman Drive and Orchard Hill Road, be temporarily closed to through  
traffic annually beginning in 2002 for the period December 1<sup>st</sup>. To March 31<sup>st</sup>.

(2) THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the 1<sup>st</sup>. Day of December,  
2002.
