## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW #2439 (2002)

Being a by-law to assume the subdivision known as "Stonegate Estates".

WHEREAS by By-law No. 1911 (1997), the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham entered into a Subdivision Agreement with 978824 Ontario Limited with respect to the lands and development known as "Stonegate Estates";

AND WHEREAS all of the terms and conditions under the said subdivision agreements have been met;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it desirable to assume the said subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the roads and/or streets as shown on Registered Plan 59M-240 be dedicated for the use of the public as a public highway and that the public highway be named "STONEGATE PLACE".
- (2) THAT all services pursuant to the Stonegate Estates Subdivision Agreement are hereby accepted by the Town and the Town hereby assumes the said subdivision for municipal purposes, the said subdivision being described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
- (3) THAT this by-law shall take effect upon the passing thereof.
