## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW NO. 23

BEING A BY-LAW FOR THE DESTRUCTION OF CERTAIN RECORDS OF THE CORPORATION.

WHEREAS By the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 249, Section 248, Sub -section (b) the Council is empowered to pass by-laws for the destruction of receipts, vouchers, instruments, rolls and other documents, records and papers;

ANDWHEREAS Certain documents of the former Township of Pelham and Village of Fonthill, peior to the first day of January 1963 are of no further use, and now occupy space which is required for other purposes;

ANDWHEREAS It is therefore desirable to destroy such documents;

NOW THEREFORE Be it enacted as a by-law of the Town of Pelham as follows:

1. The following documents and records of the former Village of Fonthill, former Township of Pelham, and former Fonthill Public Utilities Commission, all of which relate to transactions and matters completed on or before the first day of January 1963, shall be destroyed:

Return tax & Assessment
Notices
Cheque stubs
Copies of licenses
Copies of Requisitions
and Purchase Orders
Rough Payrolls
Election Papers
Copies of estimates
Sales Invoices
Paid cheques
Accounts Payable Ledger
Cards (Subsidiary records)

Tax receipts
Assessment appeals

General Account Invoice vouchers Bank Pass Book

Time Distribution Sheets
Rough Minutes
Accountants Working Papers
Public Works Contract Forms
Correspondence
Paid debentures and Coupons
Accounts Receivable Ledger
Cards (Subsidiary records)

- 2. The destruction of such records and documents shall be accomplished by burning the same in the presence of the Clerk and/or Treasurer, who shall thereafter certify to Council the destruction of said documents.
- 3. This by-law shall be effective on receipt of the approval of the Department of Municipal Affairs.
