

THE CORPORATION OF THE  
TOWN OF PELHAM  
BY-LAW #2546 (2004)

Being a by-law to repeal By-law #2257 (2001), being a by-law to authorize participation in the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement System (OMERS) in respect of its Head of Council and Councillors.


WHEREAS pursuant to By-law #2257 (2001), the Corporation of the Town of Pelham elected to participate in the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement System (OMERS) in respect of its councillors including its Head of Council as of the 1<sup>st</sup>. day of January, 2001;


AND WHEREAS it is now deemed expedient to withdraw Council's participation in OMERS;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) The employer hereby elects to withdraw participation in OMERS in respect to its Councillors including the Head of Council, effective December 1, 2003 and authorizes the CAO to submit forthwith this election in writing by provision of a certified copy of this by-law to the President of the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Board.
- (2) The Employer hereby certifies that all Councillors, including Head of Council, of the Employer who are members of the OMERS Pension Plan have authorized the employer, by secret ballot, to withdraw from the Plan.
- (3) THAT By-law #2257 (2001) be and is hereby repealed.
