

TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW NUMBER 264 (1974)

BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT SOLICITORS
FOR THE TOWN OF PELHAM

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Pelham deem it advisable to employ solicitors on behalf of the said Town

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE

TOWN OF PELHAM AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT the firm of Brooks, Macfarlane be employed as Town solicitors effective as of the date of passing of this By-law.
2. THAT the Town shall have prior claim to the services of the said solicitors in all actions or proceedings brought by, or against the said Town, and the solicitors agree not to act or permit any member of their firm to act in any way contrary to the interests of the said Town.
3. The Solicitors shall carefully and promptly attend to all legal business for and on behalf of the said Town and will attend meetings of Council when so requested by the Mayor.
4. The Solicitors shall advise from time to time, as required, the Mayor and other municipal officers.
5. The Solicitors, if requested, shall draw all by-laws, resolutions or agreements which may be required by the Town or by the Officials thereof from time to time in accordance with the business of the said Town.
6. The Solicitors, at their own expense, shall provide their own secretarial, stenographic and telephone service and shall give due priority in their office work to the legal business of the Town.
7. The fees of the Solicitors for performing legal services on behalf of the Town shall be in accordance with the usual charges made by solicitors practicing in the Niagara Peninsula. The Solicitors agree that any such fees may be reviewed on request of Council.

8. This by-law shall constitute an agreement as between the Town and the Solicitors.

9. Section 1, subsection 2 of By-law number 226 (1974) of the Town of Pelham be and the same is hereby repealed.
