

THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWN OF PELHAM
BY-LAW NO. 2649 (2005)

Being a by-law to adopt an Emergency Management Program and
Emergency Response Plan governing the provision of necessary
services during an emergency.

WHEREAS the Emergency Management Act, R.S.O., 1990, c.E.9, amends the
provisions of the former Emergency Plans Act and requires that:

1. Every municipality shall develop and implement an emergency management program
and the Council of the municipality shall by by-law adopt the emergency
management program; and,
2. Every municipality shall formulate an emergency plan governing the provision of
necessary services during an emergency and the procedures under and the manner in
which employees of the municipality and other persons will respond to the
emergency and the Council of the municipality shall by by-law adopt the emergency
plan.


AND WHEREAS Council of the Town of Pelham previously adopted By-law #188
(1973) enacted July 16, 1973;


AND WHEREAS the said procedures have been revised and amended;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN
OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the "Town of Pelham Emergency Response Plan 2004" be and the same is
hereby adopted.
- (2) THAT the "Town of Pelham Emergency Response Plan 2004" be and the same is
hereby adopted for use in the Town of Pelham as the Emergency Plan to govern the
provision of necessary services during an emergency and the procedures under and
the manner in which employees of the municipality and other persons will respond
to an emergency.
- (3) THAT By-law #188 (1973) be and the same is hereby repealed.
- (4) THAT this by-law shall come into force and effect on the day on which it is passed.
