
WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it necessary and desirable to repeal By-law #1394 (1991), as amended, with respect to the regulation of smoking in buildings under the jurisdiction of the Town of Pelham;


AND WHEREAS the Regional Municipality of Niagara enacted By-law No. 22-2002 on April 4, 2002 which regulates the smoking of tobacco in public places and workplaces and which came into force and effect on May 31, 2003;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT By-law #1394 (1991), as amended by By-law #1968 (1998) and By-law #2081 (1999) be and are hereby repealed.
