

THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWN OF PELHAM
BY-LAW #277 (1974)

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION
OF AN AGREEMENT WITH O. CRYSLER RESPECTING
THE ENCROACHMENT OF A BUILDING ON THE ROAD
ALLOWANCE.

WHEREAS by Section 354 (93) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970,
Chapter 284 and amendments thereto, Council is authorized to allow any person
owning or occupying any building that is erected upon any highway to maintain
and use such erection thereon,

AND WHEREAS Council may affix such annual fee or charges as
the Council considers appropriate for such owner or occupant to pay for such
privilege,

AND WHEREAS Council has agreed to permit the encroachment of
a verandah attached to the residence of O. Crysler, on the road allowance,
North Pelham Street, Part Lot 163, of the former Township of Thorold,

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF
PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and each of them is hereby
authorized and instructed on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of
Pelham to execute the said agreement and the Clerk is hereby authorized
to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
- (2) THIS By-law shall come into effect on the date of passing.
