

THE CORPORATION OF THE
T O W N O F P E L H A M
BY-LAW #299 (1975)

Being a by-law to appoint a canine control
officer for the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Town of Pelham has enacted a by-law pursuant to provisions of the Dog Licensing, Livestock and Poultry Protection Act for the licensing and requiring the registration of dogs for imposing a license fee on the owners of dogs and for prohibiting or regulating the running at large of dogs within the Town of Pelham and for seizing and impounding and for killing whether before or after impounding of dogs running at large contrary to the by-law,

AND WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it expedient to appoint a canine control officer to enforce the provisions of By-law #177 (1973) - Being a by-law respecting the registration and running at large of dogs in the municipality of the Town of Pelham,

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF
PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT Regional Services Limited and their employees be appointed as canine control officers of the Town of Pelham.
- (2) THAT Charles Purser, employee of Regional Services Limited be appointed as assistant canine control officer of the Town of Pelham.
- (3) THE canine control officer and assistant canine control officer shall carry out and enforce the provisions of By-law #177 (1973) - Being a by-law respecting the registration and running at large of dogs in the municipality of the Town of Pelham.
- (4) THAT the canine control officer is to be paid at such rates as agreed upon from time to time.
- (5) THE date of appointment shall take effect February 1st., 1975.
- (6) THAT By-law #258 (1974) be and the same is hereby rescinded.
