THE DRAINAGE ACT, R.S.O. 1990

BY-LAW NO. 2998 (2008)

A by-law to provide for the repair of drainage works in the Town of Pelham, known as the Disher Drain.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Pelham shall undertake the repair of the Disher Drain in accordance with Section 74 of the Drainage Act RSO 1990;

AND WHEREAS the following lands and roads are affected by the repair of the drainage works; those lands and roads in the Town of Pelham as set forth in the assessment schedule and current by-law for this drainage works;

AND WHEREAS the repair of 6200 feet of the Disher Drain shall be repaired in accordance with the report of Proctor and Redfern dated 1980 and Bylaw No. 671-81 being the current by-law pertaining thereto;

AND WHEREAS the estimated total cost of constructing the drainage work is \$12000.00;

AND WHEREAS \$12000.00 is being assessed in the Municipality of the Town of Pelham for the repair of the drainage works;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Pelham is of the opinion that the repair of the drainage works is desirable;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham pursuant to the Drainage Act RSO 1990 **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- THAT the maintenance and repair of the Disher Drain in accordance with the report of Proctor and Redfern is being authorized and shall be completed in accordance herewith.
- 2. **AND THAT** the extent of the maintenance and repair is described as follows: brushing and excavating and general repair of entire drain as necessary.
- 3. **AND THAT** the Corporation of the Town of Pelham shall levy charges for the repair of the drainage works in the proportion determined by the current by-law pertaining thereto (unless such provisions for maintenance or repair has been varied or otherwise determined by an engineer in a report or on appeal therefrom).
- 4. All assessments are payable in the year in which the assessments are imposed, 30 days following the demand date.
- 5. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the third and final reading thereof and shall be known as the Disher Drain maintenance and repair by-law.
