

THE CORPORATION OF THE  
TOWN OF PELHAM  
BY-LAW #3013 (2008)

Being a by-law to prohibit the depositing of snow or ice on any highway within the Town of Pelham.


WHEREAS the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, Section 11 (3) empowers municipalities to pass by-laws regarding highways;

AND WHEREAS The Highway Traffic Act, R. S. O. 1990, c.H.8, defines highway to include a common and public highway, street, avenue, parkway, square, place, bridge, viaduct or trestle, any part of which is intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles and includes the area between the lateral property lines thereof.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any snow or ice upon any portion of any highway located within the Corporation of the Town of Pelham.
- (2) No person shall clear away or remove snow from a municipal highway, except as may be necessary to clear away snow blocking access to a private entrance or driveway or from a sidewalk within a road allowance.
- (3) No person shall move snow within the road allowance from one side of the cleared portion of the road allowance intended for vehicular and pedestrian traffic, to the other side of the road allowance.
- (4) No person shall relocate snow within the road allowance in such a manner as to encroach on the cleared portion of the road allowance intended for vehicular and pedestrian traffic, or that would result in the obstruction of normal visibility of the safe movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic on the road allowance.
- (5) No person shall deposit snow on or within 1 metre of a fire hydrant.
- (6) That By-law #453 (1978) be and is hereby repealed.
- (7) Any person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and subject to a fine recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.
