## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW #302 (1975)

Being a by-law to dedicate certain lands as public highway.

WHEREAS Council considers it desirable to dedicate as a public highway, the public lands herein described,

AND WHEREAS Council has agreed to dedicate said land as public highway as condition of a site plan agreement entered into with the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce and National Trust Company Limited, as bare trustee for the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce, on the 21st. day of January, 1975,

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT the following described lands being:

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel of tract of land and premises situate lying and being in the Town of Pelham in the Regional Municipality of Niagara, formerly in the County of Welland and being composed of Part of Lot 32 on the east side of South Pelham Street according to Registered Plan 25 for the former Village of Fonthill and premising that the easterly limit of South Pelham Street has a bearing of North and relating all bearings herein thereto the said parcel may be more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at a standard iron bar planted in the southerly limit of said Lot 32 distant therein 137.0 feet measured on a bearing of S 89°18'15"E from the south-westerly angle thereof;

THENCE NORTH 61.5 feet to an iron bar planted in the southerly limit of an 8.9 foot right-of-way;

THENCE N  $89^{\circ}39$ 'E along said southerly limit 29.95 feet to an iron bar;

THENCE NORTH along the easterly limit of said right-of-way, 8.0 feet;

THENCE N 89°39'E, 1.0 foot;

THENCE South, 9.0 feet;

THENCE S 89039'W, 29.95 feet;

THENCE South, 60.52 feet more or less to a point in the southerly limit of said Lot distant therein 1.0 foot measured on a bearing of S  $89^{\circ}18'15''$ E from the point of commencement;

THENCE N  $89^{\circ}18'15''$ W along said southerly limit of Lot 32, 1.0 foot to the point of commencement.

BE AND THEY ARE HEREBY LAID OUT, OPENED AND DEDICATED for the use of the public as a public highway and be known as part of the <u>Municipal Court</u>.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED IN COUNCIL THIS 10th. DAY OF March, 1975 A.D.
