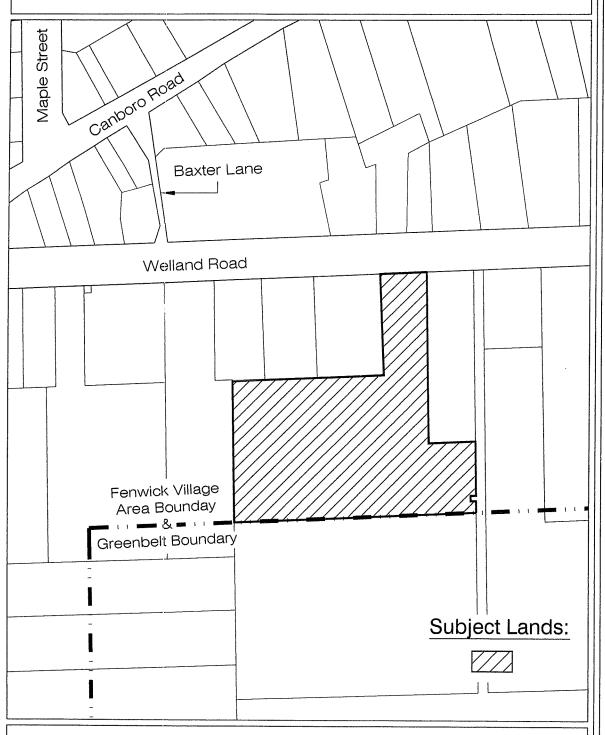

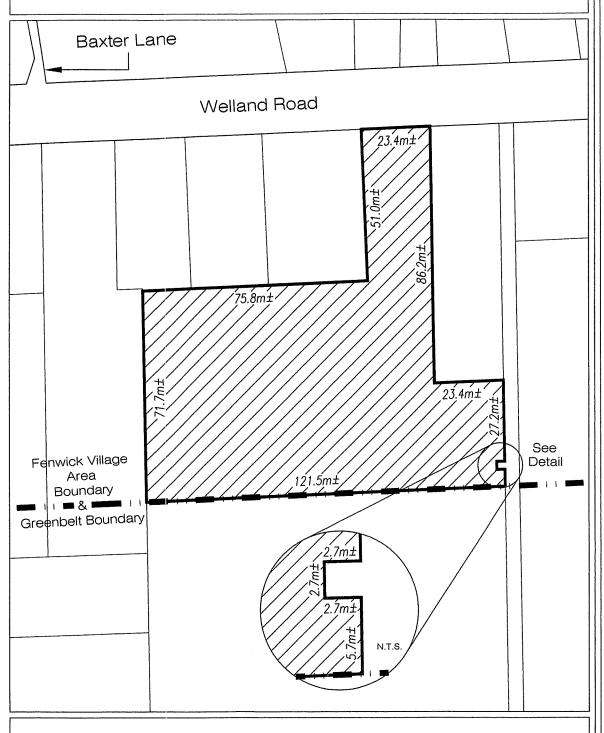

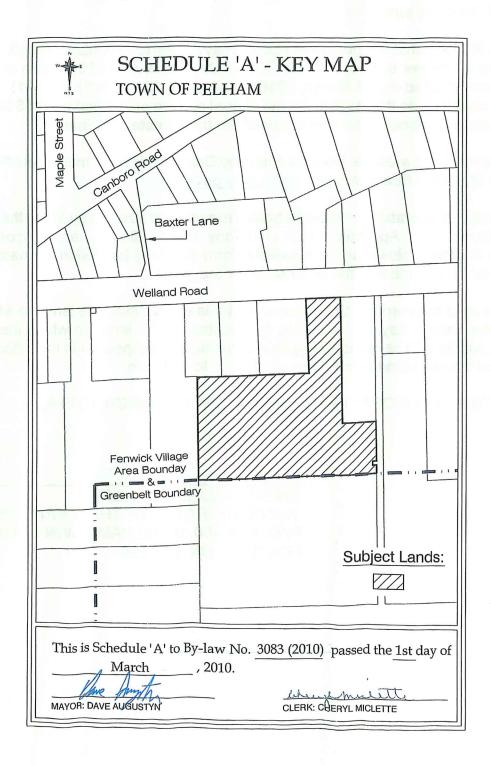

However, an Appellant Form (A1) may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or the group.
