Being a by-law to dedicate a one foot reserve,
known as Lot 9, Plan 26, on the west side of
Cherry Street as Public Highway.

WHEREAS Council considers it desirable to dedicate as a
public highway, the lands herein described;

AND WHEREAS Lot 9, of Registered Plan 26 for the former
Township of Pelham, now in the Town of Pelham, was intended to be dedicated
as public highway as indicated by the owner's dedication and signature
endorsed on the plan;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF
PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT the following described lands, being ALL AND SINGULAR that certain
parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the Town
of Pelham, in the Regional Municipality of Niagara, formerly in the Township
of Pelham, in the County of Welland, and being composed of Lot 9, according
to Registered Plan #26 for the former Township of Pelham, now known as Plan
713 in the Registry Division of Niagara South, BE AND THEY ARE HEREBY laid
out opened and dedicated for the use of the public as a public highway and
Lot 9 shall henceforth form a part of Cherry Avenue and be so known.
