

THE CORPORATION OF THE  
T O W N O F P E L H A M  
BY-LAW #325 (1975)

Being a by-law to authorize and provide for  
an addition to Station #2 Fire Hall.

WHEREAS Section 354 (1), subsection 25 of the Municipal Act,  
R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284 authorizes the Council's of local municipalities  
to pass by-laws for requiring land and erecting thereon a fire hall for fire  
fighting and fire protection and for issuing debentures therefor without  
the consent of the electors;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of  
Pelham considers it necessary for the adequate protection of the property  
in the municipality to erect an addition to Fire Station #2;

AND WHEREAS tenders have been obtained for costs of the  
addition;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it advisable to proceed with the  
construction of an addition to Station #2 Fire Hall;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM  
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the Town of Pelham proceed with the construction of an addition  
to Station #2 Fire Hall and the issue of debentures in the amount of \$40,000  
to pay for same.
- (2) THAT the Treasurer subject to the approval of Council may agree with  
any bank or persons for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the  
addition to Fire Station #2.
- (3) THAT the debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for  
the cost of the addition, shall be issued by the Regional Municipality of  
Niagara and shall bear interest at such rate as Council of the Regional  
Municipality of Niagara may determine and shall be payable in a ten (10)  
year period.
- (4) THAT the amounts of principal and interest and any other amounts required  
to retire the said debentures shall be charged to and payable by the  
Corporation of the Town of Pelham pursuant to Subsection 1, Section 57 of  
the Regional Municipality of Niagara Act, 1968-69.
- (5) THAT this by-law shall not come into force or take effect until it has  
been approved by the Ontario Municipal Board.
