## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW NO. 3375 (2013)

Being a by-law to designate the Fenwick Flag Pole

WHEREAS pursuant to Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O., 1990, the Council of a municipality is authorized to enact by-laws to designate a real property, including buildings and structures thereon, to be of cultural heritage value or interest.

WHEREAS the municipal council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham has cause to be served on the owner (The Corporation) of the lands and premises at:

Part of the Original Road Allowance between Lots 15 & 16, Concession 9, Former Township of Pelham, Now in the Town of Pelham Regional Municipality of Niagara (Intersection of Canboro Road and Maple Street)

and upon the Ontario Heritage Trust, notice of intention to designate the Fenwick Flag Pole and a statement of the reasons for the proposed designation, and further, has caused said notice of intention to be published in the Welland Tribune, being a newspaper of general circulation in the municipality;

AND WHEREAS no objections to the proposed designation have been received;

AND WHEREAS the reasons for designation and extent to which the designation applies are set out in Schedule "B" attached hereto and form part of this By-law.

## **COUNCIL ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1. THAT the following real property, more particular described in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this By-law is hereby designated as being of cultural heritage value or interest:
- 2. THAT the Town solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" attached hereto at the Land Registry Office.
