

THE CORPORATION OF THE
T O W N O F P E L H A M
BY-LAW #345 (1975)

Being a by-law to authorize and provide for
the purchase of a 625 G.P.M. self-propelled
fire truck.

WHEREAS Section 354 (1), Subsection 25 of the Municipal
Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284 authorizes the Council of local municipalities
to pass by-laws for purchasing and installing fire engines, apparatus,
and appliances for fire fighting and fire protection and for issuing
debentures therefor without the consent of the electors;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town
of Pelham considers it necessary for the adequate protection of the
property in the municipality to replace a 20 year old fire truck with a
new 625 G.P.M. fire truck;

AND WHEREAS estimates have been obtained for costs of
the equipment required,

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF
PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the Town of Pelham purchase a new 625 G.P.M. self-propelled
fire truck ~~replaced~~ ^{xxxxxxx} at an estimated cost of \$38,000.
- (2) THAT the Treasurer subject to the approval of Council may agree
with any bank or persons for temporary advances of money to meet the
cost of the fire salvage truck and equipment.
- (3) THAT the debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to
pay for the cost of the fire truck and equipment shall be issued by
the Regional Municipality of Niagara and shall bear interest at such
rate as Council of the Regional Municipality of Niagara may determine
and shall be payable in a ten (10) year period.
- (4) THAT the amounts of principal and interest and any other amounts
required to retire the said debentures shall be charged to and payable
by the Corporation of the Town of Pelham pursuant to Subsection 1,
Section 57 of the Regional Municipality of Niagara Act, 1968-69.
- (5) THIS by-law shall not come into force or take effect until it
has been approved by the Ontario Municipal Board.
