THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW #3471 (2014)

Being a by-law to Repeal various By-laws pertaining to Municipal Elections, being By-law #1433(1991), being a by-law to authorize the use of composite ballots at a municipal election; By-law #3087(2010) to provide for advance votes for the 2010 Municipal Election; and By-law #3122(2010) to establish voting places at institutions or retirement homes for the 2010 Municipal Election.

WHEREAS Council for the Town of Pelham passed By-law No. 1433(1991) on September 16th, 1991 to authorize the use of composite ballots at a municipal election, pursuant to the Municipal Elections Act, R.S.O. 1980, as amended;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996, Section 41(4) gives authority to the Clerk to determine if composite ballots are to be used, making the former by-law no longer valid;

AND WHEREAS various By-laws pertaining to the 2010 Municipal Election are no longer valid;

AND WHEREAS Council for the Town of Pelham has been presented with the appropriate By-laws governing the 2014 Municipal Election;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT by-laws #1433 (1991), By-law #3087(2010); and By-law #3122(2010) be and are hereby repealed.
