THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW #3473 (2014)

Being a by-law to authorize the use of Optical Scanning Vote Tabulators and Touch Screen Vote Tabulators at Municipal Elections, and to Repeal By-law #2182(2000).

WHEREAS Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996, c.32, as amended, provides that a municipal council may, by by-law, authorize the use of vote counting equipment at municipal elections;

AND WHEREAS Council for the Town of Pelham deems it desirable to pass such a by-law;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham hereby authorizes the use of optical scanning vote tabulators and touch screen vote tabulators for the purpose of counting votes at municipal elections;
- (2) THAT this By-law shall come into force and effect upon the date it is passed; and
- (3) THAT By-law #2182(2000) be and is hereby repealed.
