Being a by-law to designate the street for the development known as Rosewood Estates Subdivision (File No. 26T19-01013) as public highway and to name the street Rosewood Crescent

## EXPLANATION OF THE PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF BY-LAW 3536 (2014)

The subject property is a large parcel of land (approximately 31 acres/12.6 hectares) that is located north of the Town of Pelham and City of Welland municipal boundary on the west side of Regional Road 54 (Rice Road) and continues north to Merritt Road. The land is legally described as Part of Lot 175, Geographic Township of Thorold, Town of Pelham, Regional Municipality of Niagara. The municipal address is 1136 Rice Road.

This By-law authorizes the dedication of the roadway within Rosewood Estates Subdivision as public highway and is named Rosewood Crescent to the satisfaction of the Town.
