

BY-LAW NUMBER 34 (1970)
OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM.

A BY-LAW TO DEFINE AND ESTABLISH AN AREA
WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY FOR THE COLLECTION
AND REMOVAL OF GARBAGE AND TO AUTHORIZE
THE IMPOSITION OF A SPECIAL RATE, TO DEFRAY
THE EXPENSES OF SUCH COLLECTION.

WHEREAS under Section 379 of the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 249.
as amended, By-laws may be passed by the Councils of local municipalities
to define and establish garbage collection areas within the municipality
and to authorize the imposition of a special rate to defray the expenses of
such collection upon all the rateable property in the defined area or areas.

AND WHEREAS there are no provisions in the Regional Municipality of Niagara
Act, 1968-69 that conflict with the provisions of the Municipal Act re-
specting the collection of garbage.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS
AS FOLLOWS:-

1. ALL LANDS within the Town of Pelham composed and con-
tained in the former Village of Fonthill together with all lands in that
part of the former Township of Thorold, now within the limits of the Town
of Pelham, are hereby defined and established as a garbage area to be known
as Garbage Area No. 1 of the Town of Pelham.

2. ALL COSTS and expenses for the collection and removal
of garbage from the said Area No. 1, and the disposal thereof, shall be
borne by such special annual rate, as may be fixed and imposed by Council,

upon all the rateable property within the said area.

3. THE SAID special rate may be collected or recovered in the manner provided by Section 485 of the Municipal Act.
