Being a by-law authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to enter into an agreement with Her Majesty The Queen in Right of Canada as represented by the Minister of Veterans Affairs under the Cenotaph/Monument Restoration Program – Restoration of the First World War Trench Mortar


WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it desirable to enter into an Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada, as represented by the Minister of Veterans Affairs (the Minister), for the purposes of participating in the Cenotaph/Monument Restoration Program whereby the Minister has made a commitment to the expenditure of funds to assist communities to properly conserve their cenotaphs/monuments which were created to honour Canada's war dead and Veterans;


AND WHEREAS the Minister has approved a contribution for the Corporation of the Town of Pelham for the Restoration of the First World War Trench Mortar project, as detailed in the Agreement appended hereto;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the Agreement attached hereto and made part of this by-law between the Corporation of the Town of Pelham and the Minister be and the same is hereby approved.
- (2) THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized and instructed on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham to execute the said Agreement and the Clerk is hereby authorized to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
- (3) THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon passing.
