- 3 THAT Lyle Merritt is hereby appointed as a Building Inspector and Deputy Chief Building Official for the Corporation of the Town of Pelham;
- $\widehat{\mathcal{D}}$ THAT the Building Inspector shall be responsible for the enforcement of the Building Code Act, S.O. 1992, c.23, as amended, and the regulations thereunder;
- 3 responsibilities of the Chief Building Official when authorized in his absence; THAT as Deputy Chief Building Official Lyle Merritt will assume the duties and
- <u>4</u> Property Standards Officers for the Corporation of the Town of Pelham; THAT Lyle Merritt is hereby appointed as a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officers and
- 5 of the Town of Pelham; responsible for the enforcement of all by-laws passed by the Council of the Corporation THAT the Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer and Property Standards Officer shall be
- 6 THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect on January 1st, 2017.
