

BY-LAW NUMBER 37 (1970)

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BEING A BY-LAW TO LICENSE BICYCLES IN
THE TOWN OF PELHAM.

WHEREAS Council is permitted to pass by-laws requiring all residents in the municipality owning and using any wheeled vehicles or any kind or class thereof, other than a motor vehicle and a trailer as defined in the Highway Traffic Act, to obtain a license, therefor before using it upon any street of the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE, COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF
THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. The owner of every bicycle in the Town of Pelham shall procure a license for his or her bicycle before using it upon any street in the municipality.
2. The fee for such a license shall be \$1.00.
3. Any person who violates any provision of this by-law shall upon summary conviction be liable to a penalty of not more than \$5.00 exclusive of costs.
4. Any by-laws of parts of by-laws of the former Township of Pelham or Village of Fonthill, inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law, be and the same are hereby repealed.
