

THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW NO. 3966 (2018)

Being a by-law to authorize the execution of an Agreement with The Town of Pelham and Her Majesty the Queen in right of the Province of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Transportation for the Province of Ontario – Ontario Municipal Commuter Cycling Program 2017-2018; AND to Repeal and Replace By-law No. 3920(2017).

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to authorize the execution of an Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in right of the Province of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Transportation for the Province of Ontario for funding under the dedicated Ontario Municipal Commuter Cycling Program (OMCC).

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of Pelham hereby enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the Mayor and Town Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the Town of Pelham a Transfer Payment Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in right of the Province of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Transportation for the Province of Ontario for 2017-2018 funding under the OMCC.
2. **THAT** the Mayor and Town Clerk have the delegation of authority to execute any and all required documentation on behalf of the Town of Pelham as required by the OMCC for 2017-2018.
3. **THAT** the Town of Pelham commits to providing funding equivalent in 2018 to twenty percent of 2017-2018 funding provided to the Town of Pelham under the OMCC.
4. **THAT** the Town of Pelham commits to implementing projects and spending OMCC 2017-2018 funding in accordance with all provisions specified in the Agreement.
5. **THAT** the Town of Pelham commits to spending OMCC 2017-2018 funding only on the following approved projects:
 - a. Assigned Bike Routes
 - b. Paving Spur Line
6. **THAT** the Town of Pelham commits that it will obtain all required approvals have been obtained for each project prior to use of OMCC funding.
7. **THAT** By-law No. 3920(2017) be and is hereby repealed and replaced with By-law No. 3966(2018).
