

THE CORPORATION OF THE
T O W N O F P E L H A M

BY-LAW #399 (1977)

Being a by-law to establish a rate for prelevy of taxes, installment dates and penalties for late payment.

WHEREAS Council of the Town of Pelham has enacted a policy to provide for an interim levy of taxes;

AND WHEREAS Council has enacted a by-law under Section 303 (b) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, to authorize a prelevy of taxes;

AND WHEREAS Council may provide under Section 527 (1) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, that the prepayment of taxes may be paid by installment;

AND WHEREAS under Section 527 (3) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Council may by by-law impose a percentage charge of penalty for non-payment of taxes or installment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT the rate to be used and applied for the prelevy shall be 60 mills.

(2) THAT the amount of the prelevy shall be due and payable in two installments, due March 18th. and May 13th., 1977.

(3) THAT the date of demand shall be February 28th., 1977 and shall be placed on the tax bill as the date mailed.

(4) THAT a penalty of one (1) percent will be added on the first date of default and the first day of each month thereafter, in which the default continues.

(5) THAT the Clerk-Treasurer be and is hereby authorized to mail the notice of taxes (tax bill) to the address of the residents or place of business of such person as set out in the 1976 Assessment Roll returned on the 17th. day of December, 1976.


(6) THAT payment of the prelevy of taxes will be made at the Treasurers Office at 43 South Pelham Street or at the Royal Bank of Canada, Fenwick Branch or other such financial institutes as approved by Council.

(7) THAT the Collector and Treasurer are hereby authorized and empowered to accept part payment from time to time on account of any taxes due.

(8) THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.
