NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of Pelham hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** the Holding (H) Provision affecting lands legally described as Blocks 45, 46 & 47 Plan 59M-456; in the Town of Pelham, be removed.
- 2. **THAT** Schedule 'A5' of the Zoning By-law No. 1136 (1987), as amended, be amended by removing the Holding (H) Provision from the lands zoned RM1-268(H) also shown on Schedule 'A' of this By-law.
- 3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and take effect pursuant to Sections 34 and 36 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended;
