THE CORPORATION OF THE

TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW #197 (1973)

Being a by-law to authorize the Mayor and Clerk to enter into an agreement ebetween the Niagara South Board of Education, the Regional Municipality of Niagara and the Corporation of the Town of Pelham, in order to secure a sewer easement over Part of Lots 1 to 8, Registered Plann44.

WHEREAS the Region has requested the Board to grant to the Region an easement in perpetuity over its lands described in Schedule "A" of said agreement for the purpose of a 20 inch diameter sanitary trunk sewer in connection with the South Pelham Sanitary Trunk Sewer Project,

AND WHEREAS Pelham has requested the Board to grant to Pelham an easement in perpetuity over its lands described in Schedule "B" of said agreement for the purpose of making connections to the said sanitary trunk sewer with eight-inch diameter sewer pipes,

AND WHEREAS the Board has agreed to grant such easements in perpetuity over the said lands described in Schedule "A" and "B" attached to the said agreement, subject to the terms, conditions and agreements specified in the easement document,

AND WHEREAS the consideration referred to in the easement document has been paid by the Regional Municipality of Niagara,

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the agreement hereto attached is to be made part of this by-law between the Niagara South Board of Education, the Regional Municipality of Niagara and the Corporation of the Town of Pelham.
- THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and each of them is hereby authorized and instructed on behalf of the Corporation to execute the said agreement and the Clerk is hereby authorized to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
