

THE CORPORATION OF THE
T O W N O F P E L H A M
BY-LAW #424 (1977)

Being a by-law to establish and provide
an annual allowance to be paid to members
of Council of the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS Section 389 (1) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O.
1970, Chapter 284, as amended, provides that Council of the
municipality may pass by-laws for paying the members of Council
such annual allowances Council may determine;

AND WHEREAS Section 211 of the said Municipal Act
provides that the head of Council may be paid such annual or
other remunerations the Council may determine;

AND WHEREAS Section 392 of the said Municipal Act
provides that 1/3 of such amount shall be deemed to be for
expenses incident to the discharge of his duties as a member
of Council;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the Mayor of the Council be paid the sum of
\$5,300 per annum and 1/3 of the amount shall be deemed to be
for expenses incident to the discharge of his duties.
- (2) THAT the Aldermen of Council be paid an annual
allowance of \$3,180.00 and 1/3 of the amount shall be deemed
to be for expenses incident to the discharge of his duties.
- (3) THAT the remuneration provided by this by-law will
be paid quarterly in the months of March, June, September and
December.
- (4) THAT By-law #246 (1974) of the Town of Pelham be
and the same is hereby repealed and the foregoing shall hence-
forth be in force and effect.
