THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW #426 (1977)

Being a by-law to zone the property owned by Robert Donald McCollum, Mildred McCollum and Robert Gerald McCollum to Special Commercial.

WHEREAS it is considered desirable to zone the property to permit the operation of an educational supply business;

AND WHEREAS the Planning & Development Committee of Council recommends the zoning of the McCollum property located at the corner of Webber Road and Church Street for the purpose of permitting the operation of an educational usupply establishment;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORRORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT the following parcel of land be zoned Special Commercial to permit the operation of an educational supply establishment. The regulations for the permitted use are:

(a)	Minimum Lot Frontage	299 feet
(b)	Minimum Lot Area	92,989 square feet
(c)	Minimum Lot Coverage	40% of lot area
(d)	Maximum Gross Floor Area	50% of lot area
(e)	Minimum Front Yard	40 feet

(f) Minimum Side Yard
 i) where the yard abuts
 a street, minimum 40 feet
 ii) where the yard abuts
 any agricultural or
 residential zone, minimum

25 feet

(g) Minimum Rear Yard35 feet(h) Maximum Building Height14 feet

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Town of Pelham, in the Regional Municipality of Niagara (formerly in the Township of Pelham, in the County of Welland) and being Part of Lot 16, in the 13th. Concession of said Township, more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the southeast angle of Lot 16, Concession 13 for the said Township;

THENCE northerly along the easterly limit of said lot, 310.68 feet more or less;

THENCE westerly parallel with the southerly limit of said lot, 299 feet;

THENCE southerly parallel with the easterly limit of said lot, 312 feet to the south limit of said lot;

con't....

THENCE easterly along the southerly limit of said lot, 297 feet more or less to the southeast angle of said lot and the point of commencement.

- (2) THAT as a condition of the passing of this by-law, that the owner be required to enter into a site plan agreement.
- (3) THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day of its passing, subject to approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.
