BY-LAW NO. 3334 (2013)

A BY-LAW TO ADOPT AN EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM, EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN AND TO EMPOWER MUTUAL ASSISTANCE AGREEMENTS GOVERNING THE PROVISION OF NECESSARY SERVICES DURING AN EMERGENCY

AND TO REPEAL BY-LAW # 2649 (2005), BEING A BY-LAW TO ADOPT AN EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act*, R.S.O. 1990 c.E.9, amends the provisions of the former *Emergency Management Act* and requires that:

1. Every municipality shall develop and implement an emergency management program and the council of the municipality shall by by-law adopt the emergency management program. 2002: and,
2. Every municipality shall formulate an emergency plan governing the provision of necessary services during an emergency and the procedures under and the manner in which employees of the municipality and other persons will respond to the emergency; and the council of the municipality shall by by-law adopt the emergency plan.


AND, WHEREAS The *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. E. 9. provides that:

The Council of a municipality may make an agreement with the Council of any other municipality or with any persons for the provision of any personnel, service, equipment or material during an emergency.

THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Pelham hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the "Municipal Emergency Management Program" be and the same is hereby adopted.
2. That the "Municipal Emergency Plan" be and the same is hereby adopted for use in The Town of Pelham to govern the provision of necessary services during an emergency and the procedures under and the manner in which employees of the municipality and other persons will respond to an emergency.
3. That by signature of the Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Pelham, or designate, may enter into mutual assistance agreements for the provision of any personnel, service, equipment or material during an emergency.
4. That By-law #2649 (2005) be and is hereby repealed;
5. That this By-law shall come into force and effect on the day on which it is passed.
