

The Corporation of the Town of Pelham

By-law No. 4479(2022)

Being a By-law to appoint Usama Seraj as Deputy Treasurer for the Corporation of the Town of Pelham effective upon passing, and to repeal By-law #3635(2015).

WHEREAS section 8 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 ("*Municipal Act, 2001*" or "the statute") provides that the powers of a municipality under the statute or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the statute or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS section 11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a lower-tier municipality has the authority to pass by-laws respecting the governance structure of the municipality and its local boards;

AND WHEREAS Subsection 286(2) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c. 25 provides that a municipality may appoint a Deputy Treasurer who shall have all the powers and duties of the Treasurer under this and any other Act;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it necessary and desirable to enact this By-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** Usama Seraj be and is hereby appointed Deputy Treasurer effective the passing of this by-law;
- 2. **THAT** the duties of the Deputy Treasurer shall be as set out in the *Municipal Act, 2001*, other statues dealing with matters of municipal administration and as provided by by-laws, resolutions and directions of Council;
- 3. **THAT** By-law 3635(2015) being a by-law to appoint Charlotte Tunikaitis as Deputy Treasurer for the Corporation of the Town of Pelham be and is hereby repealed and replaced.

4. Effective Date

4.1. This By-law shall come into force on the date that it is enacted.
