THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW #453 (1978)

Being a by-law to prohibit the depositing of snow and ice on highways in the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS Paragraph 1 of Section 460 of The Municipal Act provides that the Councils of all municipalities may pass by-laws for prohibiting or regulating the obstructing, encumbering, injuring or fouling of highways or bridges;

AND WHEREAS The Council of The Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it desirable to prohibit persons from obstructing or encumbering highways in the Town of Pelham by depositing snow or ice thereon;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) In this by-law,
 - (a) "deposit" includes throw, push or place by any means;
- (b) "highway" means a common and public highway under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham and includes a street and a bridge forming a part of a highway or on, over or across which a highway passes.
- (2) No person shall deposit snow or ice from private property on the sidewalk or the roadway of any highway.
- (3) Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this by-law shall forfeit and pay, at the discretion of the convicting Provincial Judge or Justice of the Peace, a penalty not exceeding (exclusive of costs) the sum of \$300.00 for each offence and such penalty shall be recoverable under The Summary Convictions Act.
- (4) That this by-law shall come into effect and take force upon the final passing by Council.
