Being a By-law to appoint Calum Bowie (Officer No. 505) as a By-law Enforcement Officer and Provincial Offences Officer for the Corporation of the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS ~~section 15(1) of the *Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 15* provides that a municipal council may appoint~~ persons to enforce the by-law of the municipality who shall be peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham enacts as follows:

1. Appointment

- 1.1. Calum Bowie is hereby appointed as Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer, Property Standards Officer and Provincial Offences Officer for the Corporation of the Town of Pelham.
- 1.2. As a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer, Property Standards Officer and Provincial Offences Officer, Calum Bowie shall be authorized and responsible for the enforcement of all by-laws passed by the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham.

2. Repeal and Enactment

- 2.1. By-laws 33-2023, 4244(2020), 3768(2016), 3741(2016), 3736(2016), 3510(2014), 3350(2013), 3168(2011), 3167(2011), 3129(2010), 3062(2009), 3039(2009), 3015(2008), 2995(2008) are hereby repealed and replaced.

3. Effective Date

- 3.1. This By-law shall come into force on the date that it is enacted.
