THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW #471 (1978)

Being a by-law to amend By-law #424 (1977) as amended to alter Council Stipends.

WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to increase the stipend paid to members of Council;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT Section 1 of By-law 424 (1977) be repealed and replaced with the following:

"Section 1 - THAT the Mayor of the Council be paid an annual stipend of \$5,565 per annum and one-third of the amount shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of his duties."

(2) THAT Section 2 of By-law #424 (1977) be repealed and replaced with the following:

"Section 2 - THAT the Aldermen of Council be paid an annual stipend of \$3,339 and one-third of the amount shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of his duties."

(3) THAT this by-law come into force and take effect on third reading and passing by Council.
