

THE CORPORATION OF THE
T O W N O F P E L H A M
BY-LAW #474 (1975)

Being a by-law to change the name of the
roadway entrance to the Municipal Building.

WHEREAS Paragraph 97 of Subsection 1 of Section 354 of
the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284, as amended, provides that
by-laws may be passed by the Councils of local municipalities for
changing the names of highways by a vote of at least three-fourths
of all the members of Council;



AND WHEREAS the roadway leading to the Municipal
Building and parking was established as a municipal road allowance
under By-law #159 (1972) and named the "Municipal Court";

AND WHEREAS Council in studying the development of
the downtown core feels it is more appropriate to refer to the area
as the Pelham Town Square;



NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN
OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the name of the street "Municipal Court" as described
in By-law #159 (1972) be changed to "Pelham Town Square".
- (2) THAT the provisions of By-law #159 (1972) are amended
accordingly.
- (3) THAT this By-law with the certificate of the Judge of
the Judicial District of Niagara South attached shall take effect from
and after there registration thereof in the Registry Office for the
Registry Division of Niagara South.
