BY-LAW NUMBER 47 (1970)

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

A by-law to establish a rate for prelevy of Taxes, installment date and penalties for late payment.

WHEREAS Council has enacted a by-law under section 294a of the Municipal Act to authorize a prelevy of taxes and

WHEREAS it is deemed experient to establish a rate, installment date and penalties for late payment,

NOW THEREFORE, Council of the Town of Pelham enacts as follows:-

- 1. The rate to be used and applied for the prelevy shall be 40 mills.
- 2. The amount of the prelevy shall be paid in one installment and shall be due June 15th., 1970.
- 3. A penalty of one percent will be added on the first day of default and on the first of each month thereafter in which default continues.
- 4. The Clerk/Treasurer be and is hereby authorized to mail the notice (tax bill) to the address of the residence or place of business of such person.
- 5. All the bills shall be paid into the office of the Clerk-Treasurer.
- 6. The collector and Treasurer are hereby empowered to accept part payment from time to time on account of any taxes due.
- 7. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of the final passing thereof.
