

BY-LAW NUMBER 47 (1970)

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

A by-law to establish a rate for prelevy of Taxes, installment date and penalties for late payment.


WHEREAS Council has enacted a by-law under section 294a of the Municipal Act to authorize a prelevy of taxes and

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient ^{FOIEN T 8.} to establish a rate, installment date and penalties for late payment,

NOW THEREFORE, Council of the Town of Pelham enacts as follows:-

1. The rate to be used and applied for the prelevy shall be 40 mills.
2. The amount of the prelevy shall be paid in one installment and shall be due June 15th., 1970.
3. A penalty of one percent will be added on the first day of default and on the first of each month thereafter in which default continues.
4. The Clerk/Treasurer be and is hereby authorized to mail the notice (tax bill) to the address of the residence or place of business of such person.
5. All the bills shall be paid into the office of the Clerk-Treasurer.
6. The collector and Treasurer are hereby empowered to accept part payment from time to time on account of any taxes due.
7. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of the final passing thereof.
