## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW #475 (1978)

Being a by-law to amend By-law #21 (1970) of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS By-law #21 (1970) provides a plan of sick leave credit gratuities for employees of the Town of Pelham;

AND WHEREAS Council and staff negotiated to change the number of maximum days in 1977 from 180 days to 200 days;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT Section 4 of By-law #21 (1970) of the Town of Pelham be amended immediately by removing the number 180 and replacing it with the number 200, that Section 4 of By-law #21 (1970) now reads:

"The maximum number of days of sick leave credit that can be accumulated shall be 200 calendar days."

- (2) THAT this by-law come into force and take effect immediately on passing thereof by Council.
- (3) THAT all other provisions of By-law #21 (1970) remain unchanged.
