THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW #497 (1978)

Being a by-law to authorize the transfer of the funds in the "Clergy Reserve" to the "Reserve for Working Funds" of the municipality.

WHEREAS an investigation of the history of the Clergy Reserve Fund has been made;

AND WHEREAS the clergy reserve fund was established by Municipal By-law #545 passed in 1899;

AND WHEREAS By-law #545 has been amended from time to time by By-laws #748, #898 and #1344;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to transfer the clergy reserve fund into the neserve for working funds of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT all monies, notes, bonds, investments now owned in the name of the Pelham Clergy Reserve and also known as the Pelham Invested School Fund or the Fonthill Clergy Reserve be transferred to the Reserve for Working Funds for the Town of Pelham.
- (2) THAT By-law #545 and amending By-laws #748, #898 and #1344 of the former Township of Pelham be and the same are hereby repealed.
- (3) THAT THIS by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing.
