

THE CORPORATION OF THE
T O W N O F P E L H A M
BY-LAW #499 (1978)

Being a by-law to provide for the erection of
stop signs and yield signs at intersections.

WHEREAS Section 89 of The Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1970,
Chapter 202 provides that the Council of a municipality may by by-law
provide for the erection of stop signs and yield signs at intersections
on highways under its jurisdiction and every sign so erected shall
comply with the regulations of the Ministry;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF
PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT the intersections on highways set out in Column 1
are designated as intersections where stop signs shall be erected
at the locations shown in Column 2:

<u>Column 1 - Intersections</u>	<u>Column 2 - Facing Traffic</u>
North & South Intersections - Both Intersections	

Centre Street & Foss Road	South bound traffic on Centre Street
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Centre Street & Foss Road	North bound traffic on Centre Street
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(2) THAT the intersections on highways set out in Column 1 are
designated as intersections where yield right-of-way signs shall be
erected at the locations shown in Column 2:

<u>Column 1 - Intersection</u>	<u>Column 2 - Facing Traffic</u>
Effingham Street & Chantler	

Road

North bound traffic on Effingham Street

(3) THAT the penalties provided in Section 152 of The Highway
Traffic Act shall apply to offences against this by-law.

(4) THAT each designation made by Section 1 and 2 shall not become
effective until said signs have been erected in accordance with the
regulations of The Highway Traffic Act.
