1. Metered -

Basic Rate For the first 18.269 M³
(4,000 gallons) per
month or part thereof

Overage

All water used and consumed over and above the 18.269 M³ (4,000 gallons) minimum rate shall be charged at

\$.90 per 4.56 M³ (1,000 gallons)

2. Non-Metered Rates -

Multiple Occupancy - Where more than one selfcontained dwelling unit exists and is supplied through a
common water meter, multiple water rates shall be charged.
Similarly, wherever multiple business establishments are
operated through a common meter, multiple water rates shall
be charged. Multiple water rates shall be charged as follows:

(a) for each unit: minimum billing, plus the cost of all
water used in accordance with Schedule "A" to this by-law,
for all water used over the minimum.

<u>Dwelling Unit</u> - Shall mean one room or a group of rooms in a building used or designated or intended to be used by only one family as a single, independent and separate housekeeping establishment:

(i) in which food preparation and sanitary facilities are provided for the exclusive use of such family, and(ii) which has a private entrance from outside the building or from a common hallway or stairway inside the building

<u>Commercial & Industrial</u> - shall mean premises used for other than residential purposes.

3. Minimum Bill -

The minimum monthly bill for 18.269 M^3 (4,000 gallons) of water shall be \$3.40.

4. Water Loading Stations The charge shall be \$1.02 per 4.56

The charge shall be \$1.02 per 4.56 M 3 (1,000 gallons).

5. Penalties -

The penalty shall be 10% after due date. Due was date is 15 days after mailing.

PRIVATE WATER SERVICES -

1. Installation of Service Pipe -

The cost of installing each water service from the watermain in or under any highway (and whether under Provincial, Regional or Town jurisdiction) to the limits of the private property abutting such highway shall be as follows:

For a 19.05 mm (3/4 inch) service - \$325.00 - Flat Rate
For a 25.4 mm (1 inch) service - \$350.00 - Flat Rate
Over 25.4 mm (1 inch) to 50.8 mm (2 inch) - \$500.00 Deposit

Any service above 25.4 mm (1 inch) the installation to be installed using quotations. If the quotation is more the owner will be required to pay the extra and if the quotation is less, the owner will receive a refund.

2. On and Off Charges -

The charge for turning the water supply on or off to a private water service other than a new service shall be as follows:

8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. - \$10.00 (on)

- \$10.00 (off) - Flat Rate

4:30 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. and Saturdays, Sundays and holidays rate of \$15.00 to turn water on and \$15.00 to turn water off

METERS -

1. New Water Meters & Remote Readers -

The capital contribution to the Town for water meters and remote readers with the Town retaining ownership shall be as follows:

- (a) 15.875 mm (5/8) inch) \$75.00 Flat Rate
 (meter with remote control M³)
 (installed by homeowner or homeowners agent)
- (b) 19.05 mm (3/4 inch) \$100.00 Flat Rate
- (c) 25.4 mm (1 inch) \$130.00 Flat Rate
- (d) 38.1 mm ($1\frac{1}{2}$ inch) \$225.00 Deposit
- (e) 50.8 mm (2 inch) \$325.00 Deposit

2. Remote Readers -

- (a) Supply Rebuilt Water Meter with installation of the new type of meter by Town forces with homeowner installing remote control and wire for above noted meter \$25.00.
- (b) Rebuilt meter, remote control and wire installed by Town \$60.00.

For all other meters, a deposit will be made equal to the estimated capital cost of the meter with the final cost to be calculated on a cost plus basis taking into consideration material, labour, equipment and 10% overhead.

3. Meter Testing -

- (a) The charge for testing a meter at the owner's request as provided in Section 32 shall be \$15.00.
- (b) If as a result of testing a meter, the meter is found to be reading inaccurately and not within the tolerances as set out in the AWWA Standards, the amount of water registered by the meter will be adjusted in accordance with the error, and the bill will be recalculated accordingly and resubmitted to the customer. If the meter is found to be reading higher, the bill will be reduced and the \$15.00 charge under subsection (a) will be refunded. If the meter is found to be reading lower than the prescribed standards, there will be no adjustment and the customer will not be billed for the additional water, however, a new meter will be installed immediately, and there will be no refund of the \$15.00.
