

THE CORPORATION OF THE
T O W N O F P E L H A M
BY-LAW #542 (1979)

Being a by-law to determine the size of the
Pelham Hydro-Electric Commission.

WHEREAS Section 2 of Bill 29 being an Act to provide for
Municipal Hydro-Electric Service in the Regional Municipality of
Niagara establishes a Commission for the Town of Pelham;

AND WHEREAS Subsection 3 of Section 2 establishes the
name of the Commission as the "Pelham Hydro-Electric Commission";

AND WHEREAS Subsection 4 of Section 2 provides that each
Commission established by Subsection 1 shall consist of the Mayor
of the area municipality and either two or four additional members
who are qualified electors under The Municipal Elections Act, 1977
in the area municipality;

AND WHEREAS Subsection 5 of Section 2 provides that
Council shall determine by by-law whether the number of additional
members of the Commission shall be two or four;

AND WHEREAS Subsection 6 of Section 2 provides that for
the term expiring November 30th., 1980, the Council shall appoint
the additional members of the Commission;

AND WHEREAS Subsections 7 and 8 of Section 2 determines
the makeup of the Commission;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF
PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) The Pelham Hydro-Electric Commission shall consist of the
Mayor and four additional members who are qualified electors under
The Municipal Elections Act, 1977 in the Town of Pelham.

(2) For the term expiring November 30th., 1980 two of the
additional members referred to in Section 1 shall be appointed from
the present Fonthill Hydro Electric Commission, one of the additional
members shall be appointed from the area outside the area presently
served by the Municipal Commission, and the fourth member to be
appointed at large from any area in the municipality.
