THE CORPORATION OF THE
T O W N O F P E L H A M
BY-LAW #544 (1979)

Being a by-law to set the rates of remuneration for the Chairman and Commissioners of the Pelham Hydro-Electric Commission.

WHEREAS Subsection 13 of Section 2 of Bill 29 being an Act to provide for Municipal Hydro-Electric Service in the Regional Municipality of Niagara states that the salaries of the members of the Commissions established by Subsection 1 for the term expiring with the 30th. day of November, 1980 shall be fixed on or before the 1st. day of October, 1979 in an amount that does not exceed the highest salary paid to members of the Municipal Commissions operating in the Regional area within the meaning of the Regional Municipality of Niagara Act on the 1st. day of January, 1979;

AND WHEREAS Subsection 2 and 3 of Section 2 establishes the Pelham Hydro-Electric Commission;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the rate of remuneration for Commissioners of the Pelham Hydro-Electric Commission shall, for each of the members be \$425.00 per year with an additional annual honorarium of \$125.00 for the Chairman based on 12 regular meetings and 6 special meetings per year.
- (2) Non-attendance at a regular meeting will result in a deduction of \$25.00.
- (3) Additional special meetings over and above the number set out in Section 1 shall be paid for at the rate of \$25.00 per meeting.
- (4) THAT a per diem allowance of \$50.00 in consideration of income loss, will be paid to Commissioners for attendance at meetings or functions concerning business pertaining to their office held out of town during a normal working day.
- (5) THAT the charges for remuneration are to be assessed 100% to the Pelham Hydro-Electric Commission.
- (6) THESE rates of remuneration shall be effective October 1st., 1979.
- (7) Pursuant to Section 392 of the Municipal Act, 1/3 (one-third) of the remuneration paid under this by-law shall be considered as expenses.

(8) By-law #315 (1975) of the Town of Pelham is rescinded on December 31st., 1979.
