THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW #565 (1979)

Being a by-law to dedicate a one foot reserve - Lot 50, Plan 712 - Bigelow Crescent as Public Highway.

WHEREAS Council considers it desirable to dedicate as a public highway the public lands herein described;

AND WHEREAS the said lands are now situate in the Town of Pelham;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT Lot 50, according to Registered Plan No. 25 of the former Township of Pelham, said plan now known as Plan No. 712, be and they are hereby laid out, opened and dedicated for the use of the public as a public highway, and be known as part of Bigelow Crescent.
