THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW #574 (1980)

Being a By-law to Amend By-law #531 (1979) with respect to Regulating Signs and other Advertising Devices in the Town of Pelham

WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it necessary to amend Schedule "B", section (f) Temporary Signs subsection (4) to permit the illumination of temporary signs on a restrictive basis:

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

That Schedule "B", section (f) Temporary Signs subsection (4) of By-law #531 (1979) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"shall not be illuminated except when placed on a property for the purpose of advertising a newly established business prior to the erection of a permanent sign or as a temporary measure due to damage of a permanent sign. In any event, no temporary sign shall remain for a period longer than thirty (30) days. Illumination shall only be permitted during normal business hours."
