THE CORPORATION OF THE  
TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW #582 (1980)

Being a by-law to provide for the erection of  
stop signs and yield signs at intersections.

WHEREAS Sections 89 and 90 of The Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O.  
1970, Chapter 202 provides that the Council of a municipality may by by-law  
provide for the erection of stop signs and yield signs at intersections on  
highways under its jurisdiction and every sign so erected shall comply with  
the regulations of the Ministry of Transportation & Communications;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF  
PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT the intersections on highways set out in Column 1 are  
designated as intersections where stop signs shall be erected at the locations  
shown in Column 2.

Foss Road & Balfour Street  
Balfour Street & Foss Road  
Concord Street & Haist Street  
D'Everardo Drive & Berkwood Place  
D'Everardo Drive & Haist Street  
Berkwood Place & Haist Street  
Woodstream Boulevard & Pancake Lane  
Deer Park Crescent & Nursery Road  
Nursery Road & Spruceside Crescent  
Millbridge Crescent & Spruceside  
Fallingbrook Drive & Spruceside  
Parkhill Road & Millbridge Crescent  
Woodstream Boulevard & Spruceside  
Fallingbrook Drive & Spruceside

(2) THAT the intersections on highways set out in Column 1 are  
designated as intersections where yield right-of-way signs shall be erected  
at the locations shown in Column 2.

Shoalts Drive & Bigelow Crescent

Column 2 - Facing Traffic

Southbound in Vinemount Drive  
Eastbound on Dogwood Crescent

(3) THAT the penalties provided in Section 152 of The Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against this by-law.

(4) THAT each designation made by Section 1 and 2 shall not become effective until said signs have been erected in accordance with the regulations of The Highway Traffic Act.
