

AGREEMENT TO GRANT EASEMENT

TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PELHAM

I, GORDON HAIST, of the Township of Pelham, in the County of Welland, owner of the lands hereinafter described in consideration of the sum of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) receipt of which I hereby acknowledge, I hereby covenant, agree to grant, convey and confirm to the Township of Pelham its successors and assigns the right to erect and maintain poles, guide wires and cross-arms and the necessary appurtenances for the transmission of electrical power in and over the said lands and the right to keep and maintain them at all times in good condition and repair and for such purposes the said municipality shall have access to the said lands at any time, for its servants, employees, workmen and assigns.

THE LANDS to be affected by this easement are the following, namely:

All and Singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the TOWNSHIP OF PELHAM, in the County of Welland, being composed of part of Lot 1, Concession 8, in the said Township, more particularly described as follows:
COMMENCING at an iron stake planted in the south limit of said Lot distant easterly thereon 178.2 feet to the south-west angle of said Lot;
THENCE NORTHERLY and parallel to the west limit of said Lot, 410 feet;
THENCE EASTERLY parallel to the south limit of said Lot, 12 feet;
THENCE SOUTHERLY parallel with the said west limit 410 feet more or less to the south limit of said Lot;
THENCE WESTERLY along said south limit, 12 feet to the place of beginning.

THIS agreement shall bind my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.
